## Montgomerie Takes SAS Championship Title

*Hall of Famer collects his sixth PGA Tour Champions victory*

**CARY, N.C. (October 15, 2017)** – Colin Montgomerie fired a bogey-free 64 on Sunday to claim a three-stroke victory over Vijay Singh and Doug Garwood. The round was the lowest of the week by two strokes.

“Thrilled to win this championship,” Montgomerie said following the round. “It’s one of the favored ones on the Tour, one of the big ones. We had a great field this year and one of the strongest fields we’ve had.”

The title is his second in Championship in five weeks, after also winning the JAPAN AIRLINES Championship, the Tour’s first event in Japan. He enters the Charles Schwab Cup Playoffs ranked 7<sup>th</sup> following this run.

Montgomerie birdied the first hole to start his day. After a three-under start on the first nine holes, he still found himself one off the lead. Birdies on 12, 14, 15 and 17 moved Montgomerie into the lead for good as Corey Pavin made two late bogeys.

Consistency was the key for Montgomerie, who made only one bogey throughout the three-day event. He collected 17 total birdies, including eight on Sunday.

Fellow World Golf Hall of Fame member Vijay Singh finished T2 after a final round 66. He tied defending Champion Doug Garwood, who also closed with 66.

The victory is the sixth of Montgomerie’s PGA Tour Champions career, and 42<sup>nd</sup> overall.
